Who We Are:

SOS Children's Villages provides abandoned and orphaned children with a caring, loving home and also helps strengthen vulnerable families.

SOS Children's Villages has been working with orphaned and abandoned children since 1949. Our work has been guided by a basic principle: a loving home for every child.

Through SOS Children's Villages, kids who were alone and abandoned or at risk of losing their families can grow up safe and loved and have the opportunity to become self-sufficient.

Where We Are:

SOS Children's Villages provides services to children, youth and families at risk through its Children's Villages, youth homes, Family Strengthening Programs, kindergartens, schools, vocational training centres, medical centres, and emergency relief programs. These 2,500 programs worldwide reach over a million children and families in need.

What We Do:

SOS Children's Villages is a place that orphaned and abandoned children can call home. Our Villages offer children in need a caring, loving and secure family environment. Children live in a family home as part of their own culture and religion, in a place where their basic needs for food, health, shelter and education are met.

In every SOS Village, the SOS mother is essential to the life of the children. These women provide children who were once alone with more than a place to live; they offer love and help to create a family. SOS Children's Villages also keeps families at risk together through our Family Strengthening Programs, which help parents and their communities to protect and care for their children. Skills training and community development work help parents to become self-sufficient and prevent child abandonment.

During times of global emergencies, SOS Children's Villages supports those most affected through our SOS Emergency Relief Programs.

History:

SOS Children's Villages was founded in 1949 by Austrian medical student, Hermann Gmeiner, who felt that something had to be done to help orphaned and abandoned children following the Second World War. Since that time, SOS Children's Villages has expanded around the world, offering children without a family a loving home and expanding its work to helping families at risk to prevent child abandonment.

SOS Children's Villages is regarded as an expert in the field of alternative care of children and we helped draft the United Nations' *Guidelines for Children in Alternative Care*.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How is SOS Children's Villages different?

Our primary focus is raising children who have no one to care for them. Our model is based on a simple principle: every child deserves a home and a family. We provide both.

2. Who are SOS mothers?

In each of our SOS Children's Villages, orphaned and abandoned children are cared for in family homes by extensively trained SOS mothers. These are from the community who raise a generation of children as her own, and meet their physical and emotional needs from infancy right up to adulthood.

3. Where does the donated money go?

Over 80.5% of contributions directed overseas will support our work in the field. The rest of the money is used in Canada to administer the program and help match other children in need with new sponsors.

Donations can be designated to a particular country or particular SOS Village. Donations without designation go where the need is greatest.

4. How do I know that my donation will be managed responsibly?

SOS Children's Villages is fully committed to investing and spending the donor's money wisely and efficiently. We are a registered charity that has officially adopted the Imagine Canada's *Ethical Fundraising and Financial Accountability Code*. Staff are members of the Association of Professional Fundraisers which obliges its members to strictly adhere to *The Donor Bill of Rights*.
